Year 3	The letter sounds (phonics & phonemes) from 'Phonics & Pronunciation' lessons 1 and 2. Vocabulary from the 'Early learning Units' units. What a verb is in English.
Year 4	Language for 'Me presento'- How to say your name, age and where you live and nationality.

What key skills will I have developed by the end of this journey?

- I can describe the weather in Spanish using nine key phrases. Using this new knowledge to read and understand a Spanish weather map.
- Recognise that sentence structures in Spanish are different to English sentence structure
- Recognise the different punctuation marks

What knowledge will I know by the end of this journey?

- Recognise and recall the 9 weather expressions in Spanish from memory.
- Ask what the weather is today and give a reply in Spanish.
- Describe the weather in Spain, in Spanish using a weather map with symbols.

Communication The children will have opportunities to ask and respond to each other in Spanish. There will be a lot of listening and repeating at the initial learning stage.

Children will be reading a Spanish weather map during their lessons. They will also have many activities where they will have to read the target language.
