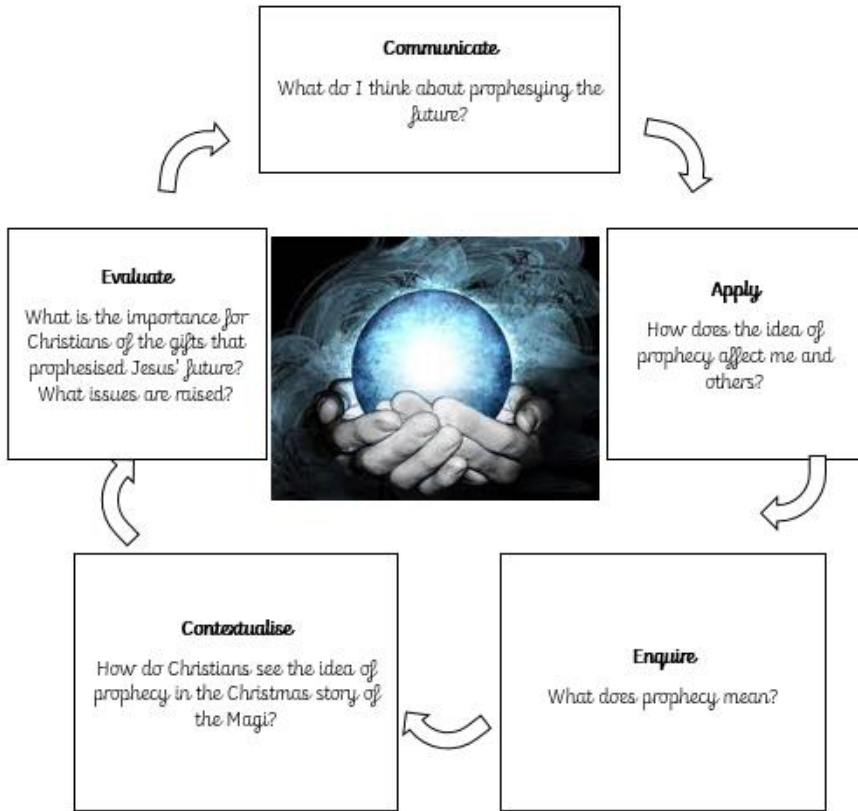


# RE Knowledge Organiser – Year 5 Autumn term 1b

## Concept: Prophecy



Key knowledge

- The three gifts given to Jesus had symbolic significance and all represented something important at that time.
- It was prophesied in the old testament that Jesus would be born in Bethlehem. Micah, Daniel and Isaiah are all books in the old testament that contain prophecies relating to the birth of Jesus.
- The Magi only visited Jesus due to divine intervention – they were very knowledgeable having read prophecies and having studied the stars.
