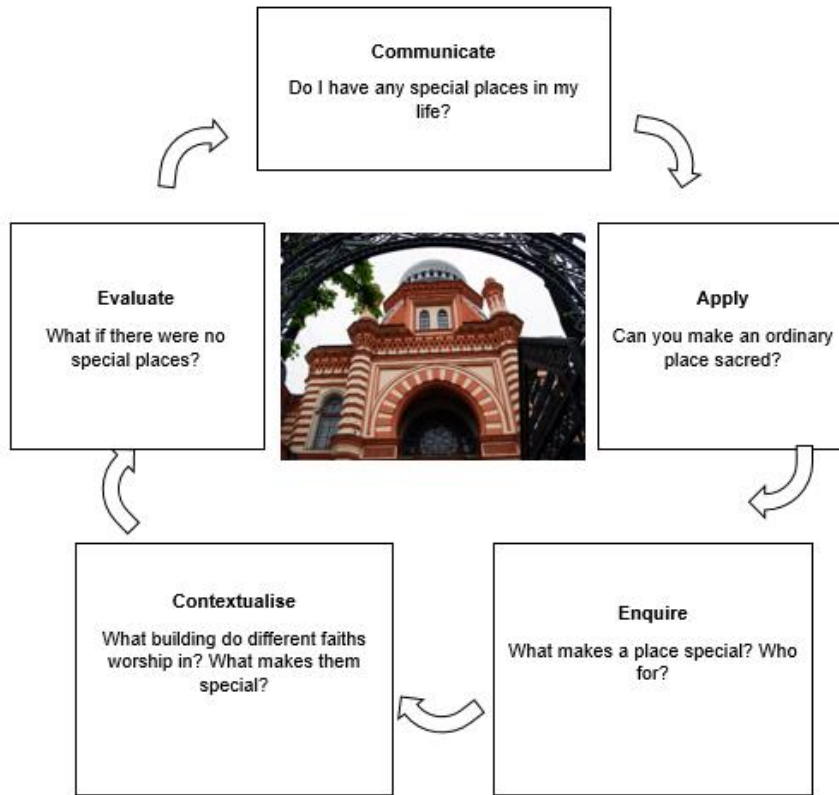

Key knowledge

- Most religions have a special building that they worship in.
- Special items are important but sacred items are not only special but also connected to God. They have religious important.
- Most religions have a sacred building in which they come together and worship. Hindus worship in a special temple.
- Which a holy building are a number of sacred items. In a Christian church these are: altar, font, lectern, stained glass window and organ

Mandir	A Hindu temple designed to bring Hindus and gods together through worship, sacrifice, and devotion	Lectern	A stand with a sloping top to hold a book or notes, from which a preacher can read while standing up	Kingdom Hall	a place of worship used by Jehovah's Witnesses
Mosque	the building where Muslims meet for religious worship	Synagogue	the building where Jewish people meet for religious worship	Altar	the table in a Christian church at which the bread and wine are consecrated in communion service
Font	a receptacle in a church for the water used in baptism	Church	the building where Christians meet for religious worship	deities	Gods, goddess or those with divine status
