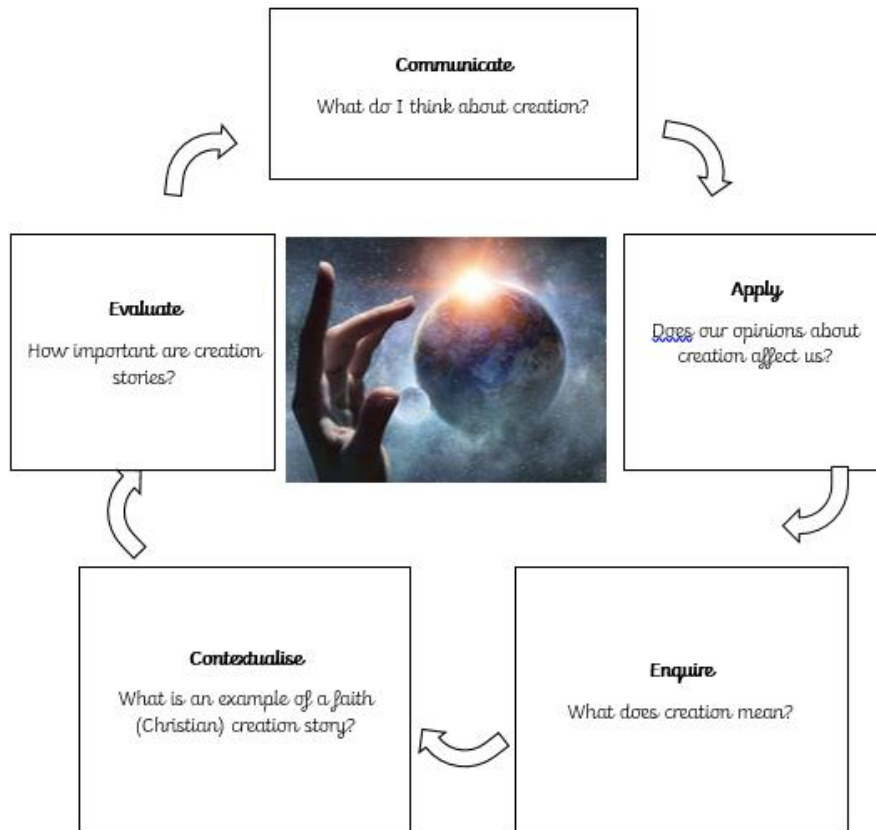

Concept: Creation



Key knowledge

A dreaming is the word used to explain how life came to be; it is the stories and beliefs behind creation in Aboriginal Australian culture.

Christians believe that God created the world in six stages: light; the sky; the earth, seas, and vegetation; the sun and moon; animals of the air and sea; and land animals and humans.

There are multiple similarities between the Jewish, Muslim and Christian creation story, all involve the creation of Adam and Eve.

There are many different creation stories suggesting ways in which the universe was created.

Was the world created or did it just happen?
Can you believe in God and science?
