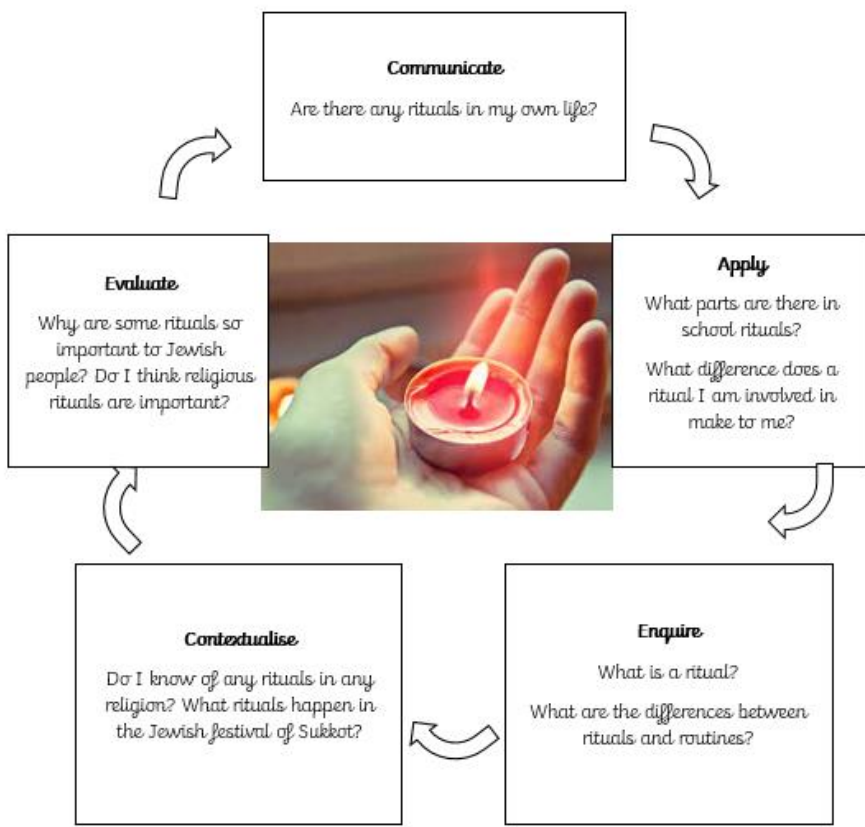


# RE Knowledge Organiser – Year 4 Autumn term 1a

## Concept: Ritual



Key knowledge

- Sukkot is a special time when Jews remember that everything comes from God. They perform a special ritual called 'shaking the lulav'.
- As part of the celebration of Sukkot, Jewish people build a Sukkah but there are rules to making the Sukkah correctly.
- It reminds Jews that their ancestors lived in tents as they wandered in the desert on their escape from Egypt to Israel.

**Main religion:** Judaism  
**Also mentioned:** Christianity.

Harvest	The period of gathering crops in the autumn	Lulav	A collection of willow branches, myrtle twigs and a palm branch.	Etrog	A citrus fruit that looks like a lemon
